RULES OF ORGANIZING THE TEAM PROJECT COURSE IN CONNECTION WITH THE DIPLOMA THESIS IN THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2021/2022

Organization of the Team Project course

1. Students complete the Team Project (TP) course in teams of 3-4.
2. Academic teachers authorized to supervise the diploma thesis report their readiness to conduct the TP course together with a proposal of a maximum of two topics. The recommended number is two.
3. Students, by completing the declaration, choose the teacher from the list of registered academic teachers along with the assigned topic of TP. The topic, in justified cases, may change.
4. On the basis of students' declarations, the following are determined: the final number and composition of the TP groups (teachers plus teams).
5. Each TP group is co-led by two or three academic teachers. The model of cooperation depends on the arrangements made by teachers.
6. In exceptional cases, the Dean's Representative may change the assignment of teachers to the TP groups.

Connection between the Team Project course and the diploma thesis

1. The teacher conducting the TP course is the supervisor of diploma theses carried out by members of these teams. One teacher can supervise at most two teams.
2. The teacher is responsible for formulating the topics for diploma theses in agreement with the members of the group.
3. Topics for diploma theses are subject to approval by the Program Committee.
4. The project team carries out two to four diploma theses. Each student prepares documentation of a selected part of the project, which can be used in the diploma thesis.
5. The diploma theses related to the TP course will be processed in accordance with the principles of the 2020/2021 academic year, provided that the applicable legal status allows it.
